Hi, Jake. Santa Claus is really your parents. Your parents give you the presents. The Santa Claus story begins with Saint Nicholas. He was a great Christian. He lived in the 4th century in Turkey. He did much to help poor people.

In a famous 19th-century American poem, "Saint Nicholas" was a fat man. He came down a chimney to give people presents. In 1863, artist Thomas Nast showed the modern image of "Saint Nicholas." Nast drew a fat man with a beard and red clothes. In the 20th century, two American soda companies showed pictures of Santa Claus. They showed him in red clothes. The pictures became famous. Now, Santa Claus wears red!

When a traffic light turns red, it is time to stop. When it turns green, it is time to go. Why does the traffic light have red and green? Why not green and orange, or red and white? It is easy to choose red and green. Red and green are opposite colors. When you put opposite colors together, each color has a clear image. So, you see their difference easily! The idea of opposite colors is easy to see with a "color wheel." Opposite colors are in opposite places on the color wheel. It is easy to select them. On the color wheel, the opposite color of red is green. So, someone decided to use red and green in traffic lights. Now, what is the opposite of yellow on the color wheel? It is purple. Many highway signs are yellow. So, a yellow sign needs to have a purple image on it, right? Well, the signs don't have to use purple images. They use black, not purple. To use black is close enough.
